This year, we have incorporated the amazing work of the BibleProject to help adults explore the big theology and themes of Easter while reading through the record of the last week of Jesus' life in the book of Luke. We've collated a few Scriptures to flesh out the videos, but we are leaving the "let it think in" up to you and the Spirit at work in you! It is our prayer that as you read and watch the videos, you will be amazed at the big-picture story that the Bible is: a complete, interconnected revelation of God's love and Redemption plan.

Palm Sunday

Today, we celebrate with the crowds; here comes Jesus, the King! Hosanna!

Holy Monday

In our readings today, we will explore the temple as we remember Jesus entering the temple and staging a prophetic protest, driving out the corrupt sellers and moneylenders.

Holy Tuesday

It is clear that Jesus meant business! The religious leaders challenge Jesus with their doctrinal traditions, but Jesus keeps responding with truth.

Read – Luke 20:1-8, Mark 13:1-8, 26-27

Jesus and his disciples enjoy a Passover meal together. As a people, they are looking back to a time for rescue from slavery in Egypt. This Passover, Jesus looks forward to a new mandate, a new command.
